



Our Treatment

Heat kills all stages of bed bugs, egg, nymph and adult.

Bed bugs start to expire at 113 degrees.

Typically a thermal treatment will take 6-10 hours. Expect to be out of your home for at least 10-12 hours for most treatments. Larger residences or those that have a lot of clutter increase cook time.

Electronics, furniture, fabrics, upholstered and other tough to treat items are easily and safely treated with heat.

All items subject to heat damage through melting, expansion or bursting must be removed from the site.

Reduction of clutter is VERY IMPORTANT in reducing time on site and provides better results.

No personal affects should be brought with you on the day of treatment. This includes un-heated clothing, purse, backpack, etc. A fresh outfit should be prepared (including shoes) by running items through a dryer for 30 minutes and place in sealed plastic bag.

Consider infestation possibilities outside of your home. These would include friends, parents, work etc. These should be systematically eliminated to prevent re-infestation at a later date.

Prepare to vacate the treated area until cool enough to return. This may take several hours depending on the substrate.

Our Thermal Remediation treatment will also include a targeted pesticide application around the rooms perimeter, bed frame and other cracks and crevices. Insecticidal dusts will also be used inside electrical outlet boxes and switch plates.
